The format of the Cambria Art Retreat includes three full days with two work sessions per day; 9 to noon and 1:30 to 3:30. We will start on Tuesday, July 15th at 10:00 at a place to be determined later. The format of the retreat has a new twist and dynamic; not all sessions will be held on location. Two of the sessions will be indoors; participants will take part in pertinent challenges and unique exercises connecting technique, philosophy and creativity.

You will be done each day at 3:30 or 4:00, giving you the late afternoons and evenings to walk the beautiful shores of Moonstone Beach as the sun sets or discover the unique shops, galleries, and restaurants located in Cambria. Just a short drive North you can tour Hearst Castle's mysterious charm or drive East to wineries and the MidState Fair located in Paso Robles. Cambria is located on Highway 1 which has plenty of beautiful scenic views and quaint towns to visit including Cayucos, Morro Bay, and San Luis Obispo.

This retreat is for all levels of artist from advanced beginner to advanced; every lesson segment can be adapted to fit the level of the student. The lesson sequences you will partake in are adaptable to a wide range subject matter, genres, styles and personal preferences. A well designed learning progression will explore the creative process, seeking pathways into merging technique, creativity and personal style. Ultimately everyone will return to their studios with theory, technique, vision, new ideas, and hopefully a renewed motivation to make art.
